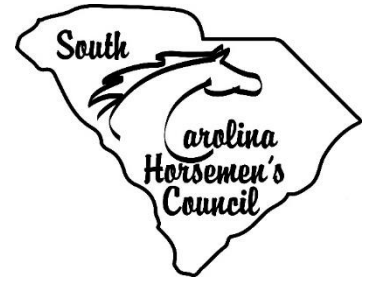


# SCHC 2018 February Meeting
